1 POLICY

In general, the flags flown at CMCC should be at half-mast in the following circumstances:

- 1. The death of someone who made an extraordinary contribution to CMCC.
- 2. The death of an exceptional Canadian or international leader.
- 3. The death of anyone where such death would result in an emotional response from a majority of CMCC students and employees, Torontonians, or Canadians.

The Vice President, Administration & Finance (VPAF) will be responsible for working with the Director of Physical Facilities to ensure compliance with this policy.

Unless otherwise indicated, flags that have been set at half-mast by virtue of one of the above situations should remain at half-mast until the funeral for the deceased has taken place or as determined by the VPAF.
