152 BECOME NEWEST DOCTORS OF CHIROPRACTIC AT CMCC CONVOCATION

He currently serves on the advisory board of *The Chiropractic Report* newsletter, has been a member of the Palmerton Hospital board of trustees since 1992 and has served as President and Officer of the NCMIC Group, Inc., since 1995. Dr. Sportelli spoke passionately about chiropractic and the important role the new graduates will play in the lives of their patients and the profession.
